The Chair of Public Finance at FAU Erlangen-Nuremberg offers two junior positions as of October 1, 2018 and January 1, 2019.

Applicants should have completed a Master's degree in economics (or should be close to completion) with focus on microeconomics and/or public economics and quantitative methods. Fluent English skills are required, German would be an asset. Fields of responsibility include participation in ongoing research and teaching. Your PhD and your participation in the PhD program of the School of Business and Economics is strongly encouraged. Participation in third-party funded research is possible

The Chair focuses on research in public economics. Current research projects deal with microdata analysis of public policy, including taxation and subsidies, as well as with interjurisdictional competition.

Salary corresponds to the German pay scale. The position can be filled immediately. The appointment is initially limited for a period of two years and can be extended for an additional three years (2+3 year).

Women are strongly encouraged to apply. Disabled applicants will be preferred when equally qualified.
